- POLISH SCHOOL LIBRARY IN REYKJAVIK HAS EXISTED SINCE THE VERY BEGINNING OF THE POLISH SCHOOL ITSELF. THE LIBRARY IS ON 6TH FLOOR, AT ÞÓRUNNARTÚN 2, 105 REYKJAVIK, IT IS OPEN EVERY WEDNESDAY FROM 17.00 TO 19.00 AND ONE SATURDAY IN A MONTH IN FELLASKÓLI FROM 10.00 TO 14.00.
- LIBRARY FULLFILS THE ROLE OF THE LOCAL CULTURAL CENTER. BOOKS ARE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL STUDENTS AS WELL AS TO ALL POLISH CITIZENS WITH THEIR RESIDENCE IN ICELAND.
- LIBRARY OF THE POLISH SCHOOL IN ICELAND IS THE INSTITUTION, WHICH MAIN GOAL IS FACILITATING ACCESS TO BOOKS IN THE NATIVE LANGUAGE AS WELL AS SATISFYING THE NEEDS AND DEVELOPMENT OF READING.


OVER 200 PUPILS

AGED FROM 5 TO 16 YEARS OLD. FOR STUDENTS THERE ARE CLASSES IN PRIMARY SCHOOL RANGING FROM 0 - 6 AND JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLASSES 1 - 3.

CLASSES ARE ON SATURDAYS, IN A BUILDING OF FELLASKÓLI, NORÐURFELLI 17 - 19, 111 REYKJAVIK, BETWEEN 9 ³⁰ - 14 ³⁰.

THE COURSE BOOKS ARE BASED ON THE CURRICULUM OF THE POLISH MINISTRY OF NATIONAL EDUCATION.

REGISTRATION



- REGISTRATION FOR THE SCHOOL IS FROM MAY TO AUGUST.
- MONTHLY FEES ARE 7500 ISK / 8500 ISK FOR THE FIRST CHILD AND 50% OFF FOR EACH ADDITIONAL PUPIL FROM THE SAME FAMILY.
 SCHOOL GIVES CERTIFICATES AND THE GRADES ARE SENT TWICE A YEAR TO ICELANDIC SCHOOLS OF OUR STUDENTS AND ARE PLACED AT THE FINAL YEARLY CERTIFICATE.
